




Info-Osmosis - Taking the puzzle out of Information and Records Management


Eraser Cube Puzzle Solution

1. Each puzzle piece may vary in colour, so the first thing to do is identify them by the number (1 – 6) imprinted on one of the flat sides.


Please note that the colours used here are for illustrative purposes only, and do not represent the actual colours of the puzzle pieces.



2. On a flat surface, arrange the pieces as shown to the right:



3. Using the ⑥ piece as the centre, fit the ①,⑤,④&③ pieces into it. At this stage, the pieces should all be flat on the surface, with the numbers facing up - the ② piece remains separate.




Eraser Cube Puzzle Solution

4. Using the ⑥ piece as the base, pivot the ①, ⑤, ④ & ③ pieces upward to form the sides of the cube. The number on each piece should be inside the cube.



Looking down from the top

5. Flip the ② piece over so its number no longer shows, and then rotate it so it is aligned as shown:



6. The ② piece will now fit into the remaining gap to complete the cube:
